Several updates from Haiti:

"Alynne,
God never ceases to amaze me!
Thank you for allowing Him to work through you and Science with a Mission and the Good Samaritan in Action Foundation. Thank you for your hard work and applying this money to Nurses for the Nations trip to Haiti.

Our Haiti team will be stationed in Cap-Haitien. We are working with Pastor Joseph Saintil of New Jerusalem Ministries in Haiti. N4N is in partnership with Maryland Community Church of Terre Haute, Indiana, for this service

project. This church has visited Pastor Joseph many times over the past several years. He has been asking for a medical team to come. This N4N team is the answer to his prayer. The team of 10 nurses will be assessing, treating, and testing about 200 people per day. **Every person will be prayed over and be exposed to the gospel message** through the morning message and the Proclaimer (an audio Bible which the team is bringing). We are praying many will get their physical and spiritual needs met. The people will be offered malaria and HIV testing. We will treat the malaria and provide education for the HIV positive patients. We will also be teaching on various health-related topics throughout the week.
